



Welcome Kings Club Members. One of our primary tenets for success at Kings Crossing Golf Club is the development of a “Community” of golfers and friends. Through our wonderful KC Premium Members and Kings Club Members, the foundation is set. Thank you for helping us “Grow the Kingdom”.

As a Kings Club Member, the following privileges and restrictions apply:

1. Unlimited Greens Fees for Open Play Monday thru Friday anytime and Saturdays, Sundays and Holiday mornings after 10am. Tee times on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays from 6:30am to 10am will be considered Premium Tee Times. Our KC Premium Members will have their 7-day tee time window available to book all of these tee times. If all tee times are not booked remaining available times will be opened for booking. Kings Club Plus and Kings Club Members booking Premium Tee Times will be subject to a Premium Tee Time flat fee \$13 for 9 holes and \$22 for 18 holes walking or riding. Kings Club Weekday Members and Non-members will be charged the posted rates. Premium Tee Time Fees ONLY apply to tee times on Saturday, Sunday and Holiday mornings between 6:30am and 10am.
2. Kings Club Members can make tee times 3 days in advance for all Open Play tee times by calling the Club or through our KC Tee Snap reservation system.
3. Cart Fees for the Kings Club Members are \$13 for 9 holes and \$22 for 18 holes for 2020.
 - * The Club reserves the right to change these rates at any time.
 - * The Club reserves the right to require cart use at busier times or due to course conditions at the Clubs discretion and without notice.
5. Kings Club Membership does not include play in any of the following:
 - Golf Leagues (Kings Club Members will be required to pay designated league rates)
 - KC Member Tournaments (Kings Club Members may play at the designated event rate)
 - Teaching and Learning Clinics
 - Golf Simulator
 - Footgolf
 - Nine and Dine Events
 - Other Tournaments or special events (Event rates will apply)
6. Kings Club Members may, and are encouraged, to get a handicap through our GHIN system. The set up and administration fee is \$45 per player for the season. Renewable annually at \$45 per year, per player.
7. Kings Club Members have access to our Club Room for room rental for personal events at designated rates.
8. ALL PLAYERS **MUST** Check into the Club with our Staff before play and declare and pay for any services prior to time of play. (Cart/Trail/Maintenance Fee, etc.)
9. Club Starter/Golf Professional/Club Staff shall control all play at 1st/10th tee. **NO PLAYER** shall proceed to 1st, 5th or 10th tee without checking in at Clubhouse.
10. Guests in Carts not playing golf shall be charged a \$5 riding fee for 9 holes \$8 for 18 holes



11. All Members may contribute to our voluntary KC Capital Improvement Program (KC CIP) with all proceeds going toward improvements to the golf course, clubhouse, maintenance equipment and landscaping. Donors receive 25% of their donation in Club Credit.
12. Proper Golf Casual Attire is Required. Jeans are allowed. **NO tee shirts**, tank tops (men), cut off shorts. Golf apparel is available in the KC Pro Shop or online at www.kingscrossinggolfclub.com/store
13. **CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT** to establish a trail/maintenance fee to apply to each walking round. A nominal flat fee of up to \$5 may be charged for Kings Club Members walking 9 or 18 holes. This trail/maintenance fee is to be utilized for continuing course maintenance and improvements. If a Kings Club Member rents a cart there will be no trail fee and standard cart rates will apply (\$13 for 9 and \$22 for 18 holes). This does not apply to KC Premium Members. *See KC Rewards Program for additional savings opportunities
14. **CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT** to establish a \$25 Minimum Monthly Purchasing in effect from May through October of each season. Purchases include (greens fees, trail/maintenance fees, food and beverage, pro shop, events/tournaments). If minimum is not reached member shall be balance billed at the end of each month via email billing. Club Credit may not be used to meet Minimum Monthly value.
15. **KC Loyalty Program-** For every \$300 spent on Food and Beverage items in the KC Pub and Grill members will receive \$10 Club Credit to be used for any purchase EXCEPT food and beverage.

At the King

All communications from the Club will be via email to the address provided at time of membership. If your email address changes or you are not receiving emails be sure to contact the Club with the proper information. Please be advised that the Club is not responsible for Members not reading or reviewing emails relative to upcoming events, discounts, policies, fees, or any other Club related issues.

If the Course is closed for weather or any other reason play is NOT PERMITTED. If Course Closed signs are presented and/or access to the Clubhouse is locked Players are not allowed on the golf course.

Players are fully responsible for any damage caused to person or property. This includes, but is not limited to other players, visitors, adjacent residences or property, vehicles or any club property. The Club shall be held harmless for any and all damage caused by players and/or guests to Kings Crossing Golf Club. It is the Players responsibility to communicate any damage with property owner. If Property Owner is not available, Player shall make damage and responsibility aware to Club staff.

Bringing alcoholic beverages onto the course that are not purchased at Kings Crossing Golf Club is **strictly prohibited**. This presents a significant liability issue and will not be tolerated. KCGC Staff shall have the right to inspect and confiscate all alcoholic beverages brought onto the property. The KC Grille is a full service food and bar providing items for your enjoyment. Players found on the course with alcoholic beverages not purchased at Kings Crossing shall be subject to a warning for 1st offense and a termination of membership with 2nd offense.

Practicing on the Course

Kings Crossing is not a Practice Facility. We offer an area adjacent to hole 5 tees for short game practice and a practice green for putting and pitching. Hitting multiple balls while playing and practicing on the golf course is prohibited. For the protection of players and the turf conditions this will be enforced.

Pace of Play

It is imperative that all players adhere to playing etiquette. At KCGC 9 holes can be played in 1.75 hours, 18 holes in 3.5 hours. This should be your guide when playing at KCGC. A Player Assistant will be monitoring play to ensure all players move at a reasonable pace. Slow play can result in a warning to speed play and/or removal from the golf course. As is etiquette please allow faster players through your group. KC offers 5 sets of tees to play from...PLEASE play from the tee which best suits your game and from where you can have the most enjoyable round. Where possible groups will be combined to speed play.
